Touchable items/hands-on exhibit



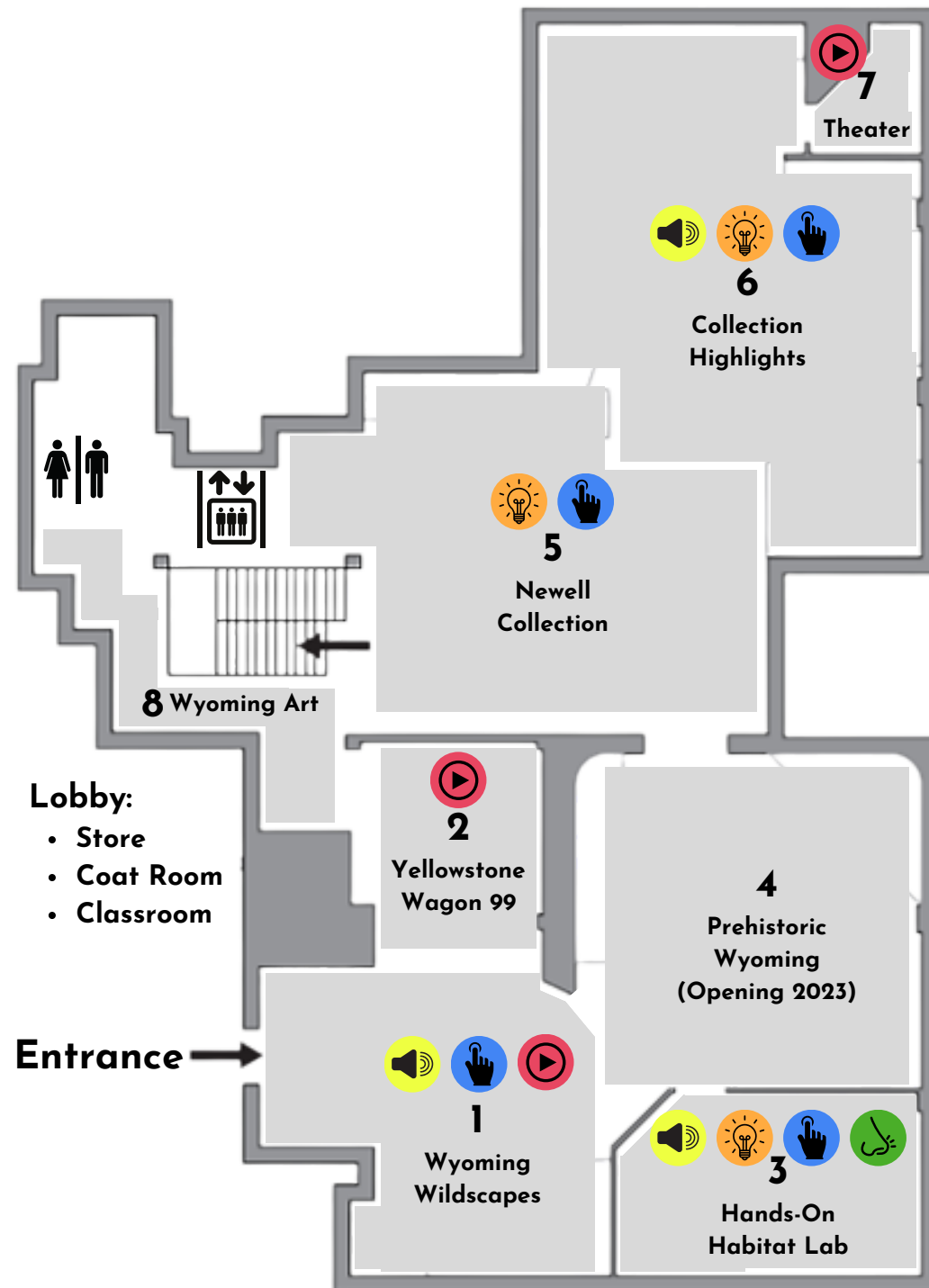

7. Theater

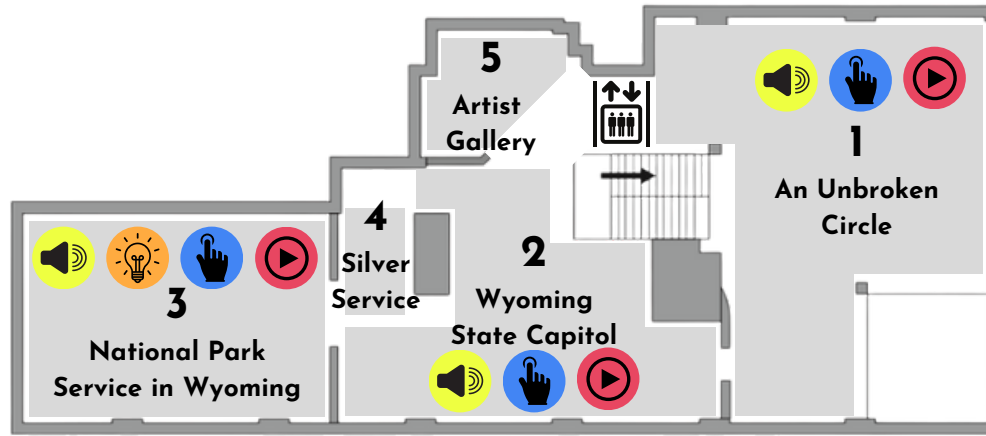
